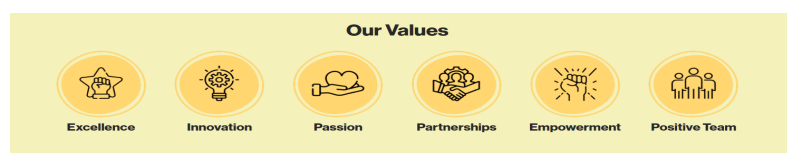

Purpose of Role:

The position involves actively promoting and gaining referrals for the One-You Cheshire East programmes. Supporting local communities to start and maintain a healthier lifestyle.

As a Community Link Worker you will play a pivotal role in supporting residents to access the One You Cheshire East service, particularly those facing health inequalities such as individuals from deprived areas or those typically difficult to engage with.



Location:

This is a community based role covering Cheshire East. Primarily covering the South area of Cheshire East (Congleton, Sandbach, Crewe, Nantwich).

Main Duties:

Responsible for promoting One You Service and supporting referrals into the One You services through building strong and trusted relationships with local residents and communities across Cheshire East, meeting service requirements, and referral numbers in line with service needs.

Be proactive in undertaking community development to encourage self referrals into One You services through engagement with local communities, particularly people with diabetes/hypertension and those would benefit from smoking cessation, physical activity, adult weight management, family weight management or falls prevention programmes and those that statutory agencies may find hard to reach and difficult to engage.

Forge strong links with local VCFSE and statutory organisations, community and neighbourhood level groups utilising their network in order to promote One You services and engender referrals.
